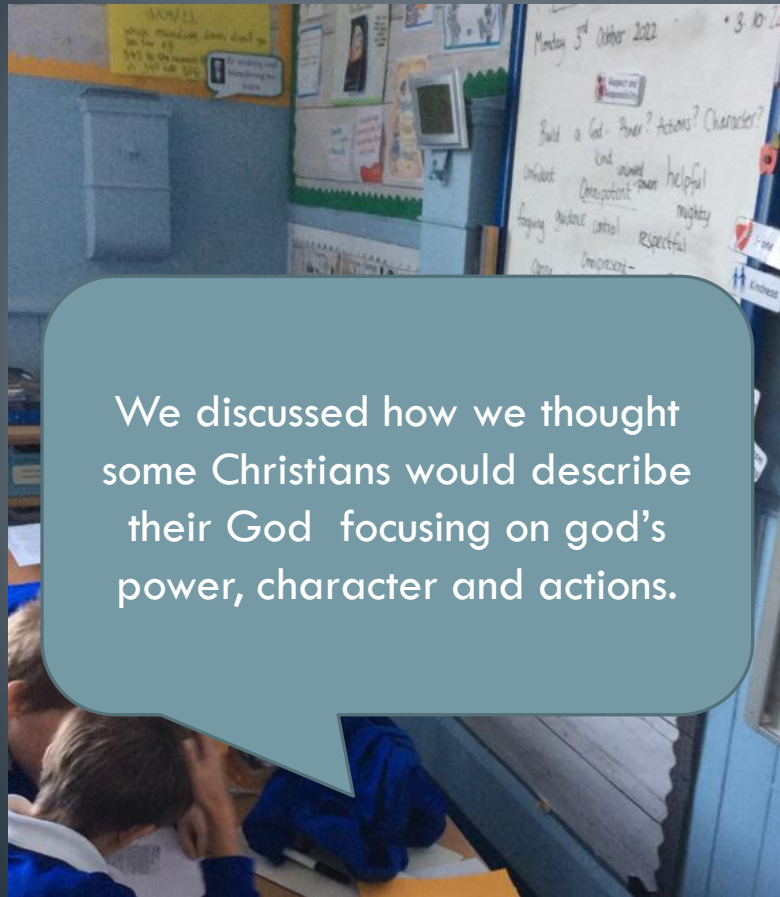

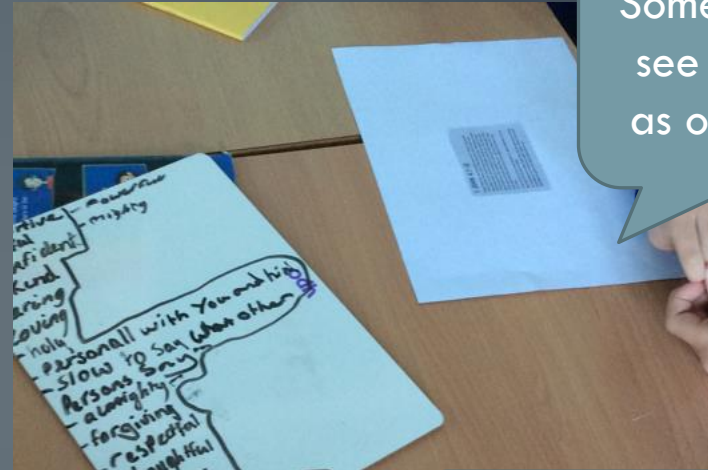
**What does it mean for Christians to

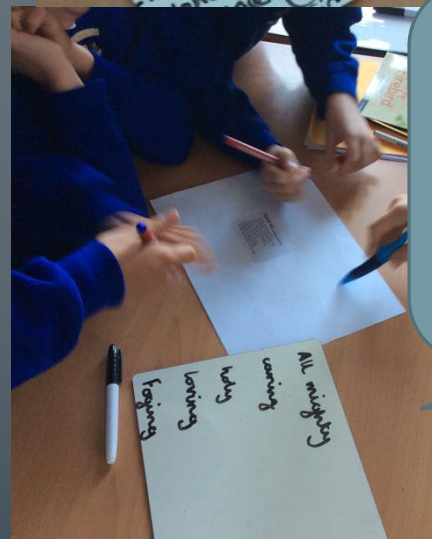
# I can identify some different biblical text to understand some Christian ideas about God being holy and loving.



We discussed how we thought some Christians would describe their God focusing on god's power, character and actions.



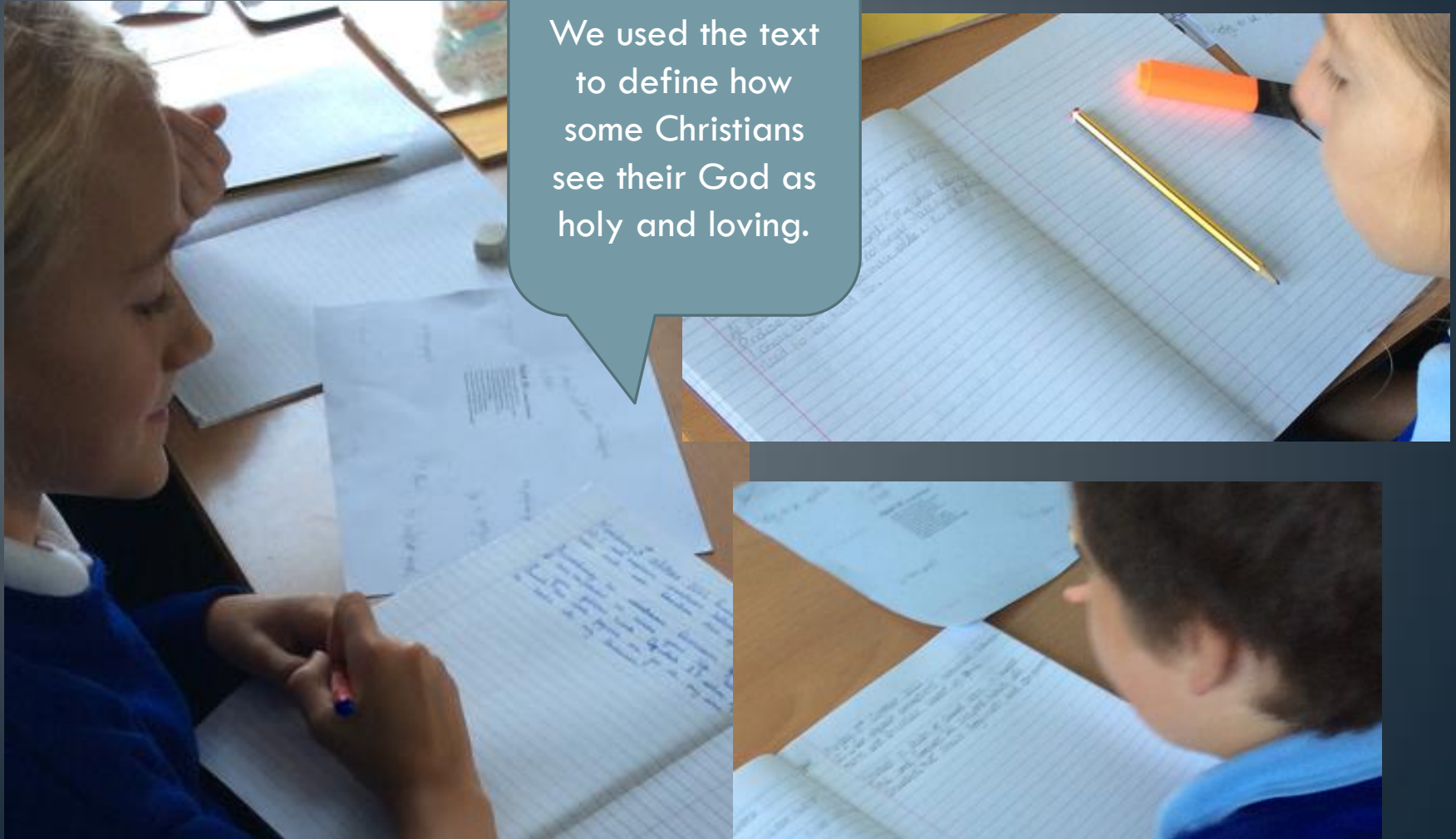
Some Christians see their God as omnipotent.

# I can understand what some Christians believe about God through the design of churches

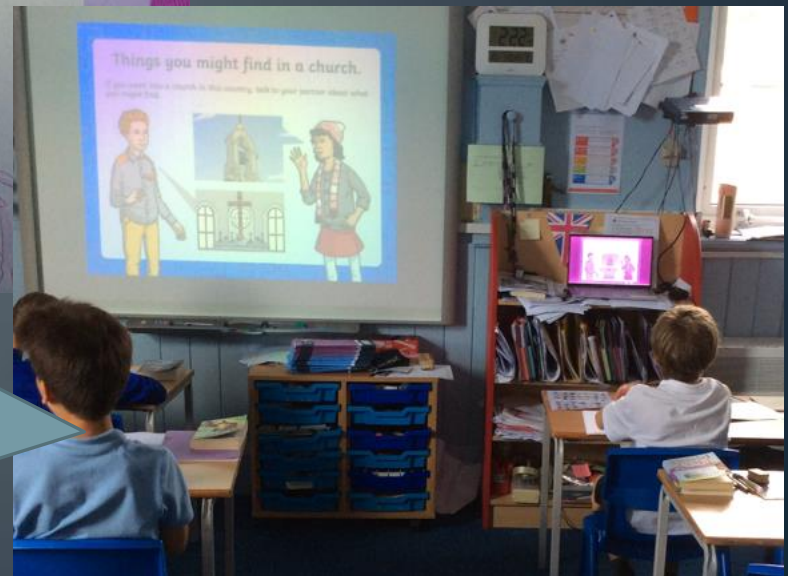
Look out for these other special features!

Some cathedrals are designed in the shape of the cross which is a Christian symbol.



Stained glass windows tell a story.

Medieval Christians designed cathedrals 'to the glory of God.'

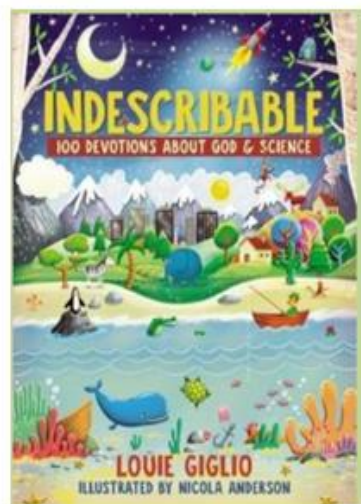
