Session 1: We learnt how to name different ways of travelling and identified types of transport using words and gestures.




Session 2: We learnt how to ask how someone goes to school and respond to this question by telling someone else how we go to school.


Comment vas-tu à l'école ?

Je vais à l'école...


We learnt how to give and respond to simple direction instructions. We then learnt how to read and say words containing the French spelling 'ch', pronounced /sh/.
