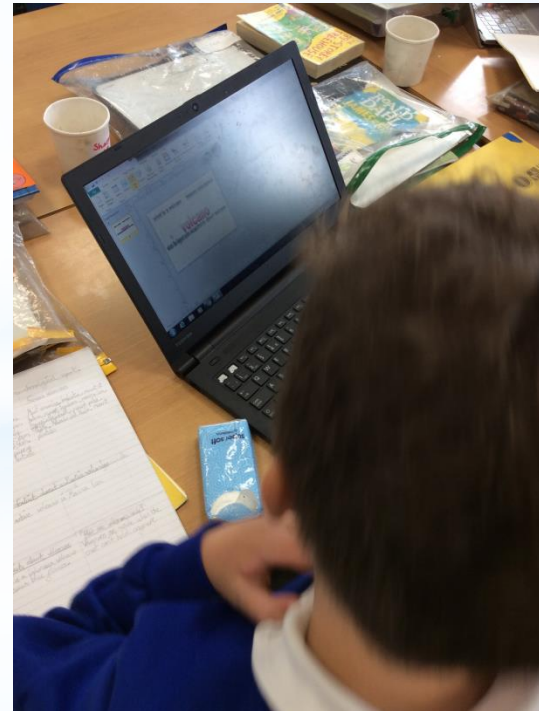

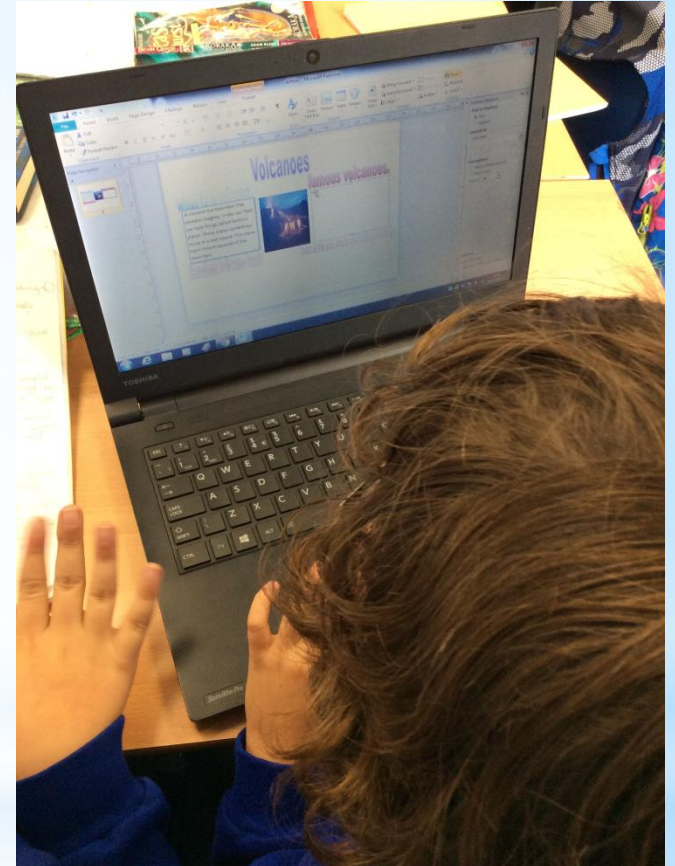
1 We discussed the difference between images and text and the importance of both. We were able to give advantages and disadvantages of using text, images, or both text and images to communicate messages effectively.

2 We looked at desktop publishing. We thought about how to make careful choices regarding font size, colour and orientation.

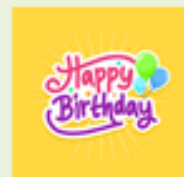




3 We used the internet to research information about volcanoes in order to create our own report in Microsoft Publisher.

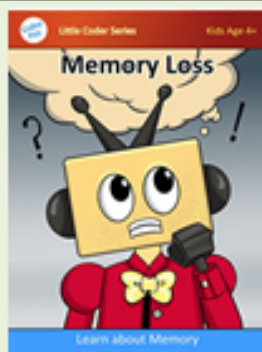

### Subject Specific Vocabulary

text	Text is actual words, whether hand written or typed. We see text used in lots of different ways in the world around us.
images	We also call these pictures, graphics, illustrations, but in this unit we will use the term 'images'. We see images used in lots of different ways in the world around us.
landscape	Landscape is when the orientation of a page appears with the longest edge in the horizontal direction.
portrait	Portrait is when the orientation of a page appears with the longest edge in the vertical direction.
Page orientation	Page orientation is the direction in which a document is displayed or printed. The two basic types of page orientation are portrait (vertical) and landscape (horizontal).
fonts	A font is a graphical representation of text that may include a different typeface, point size, weight, color, or design.
