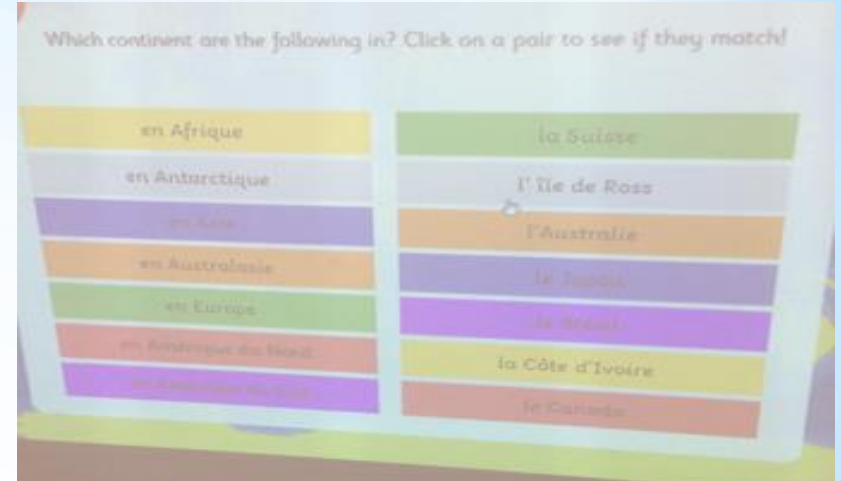

Europe.

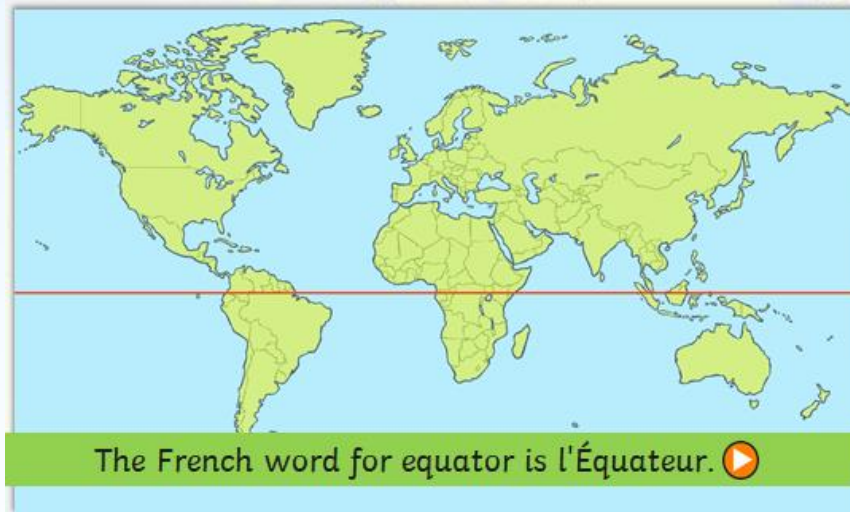
Le Kenya est en
