


We thought about what we knew about Christianity, the Bible and Jesus, including his birth and death.

and feet.

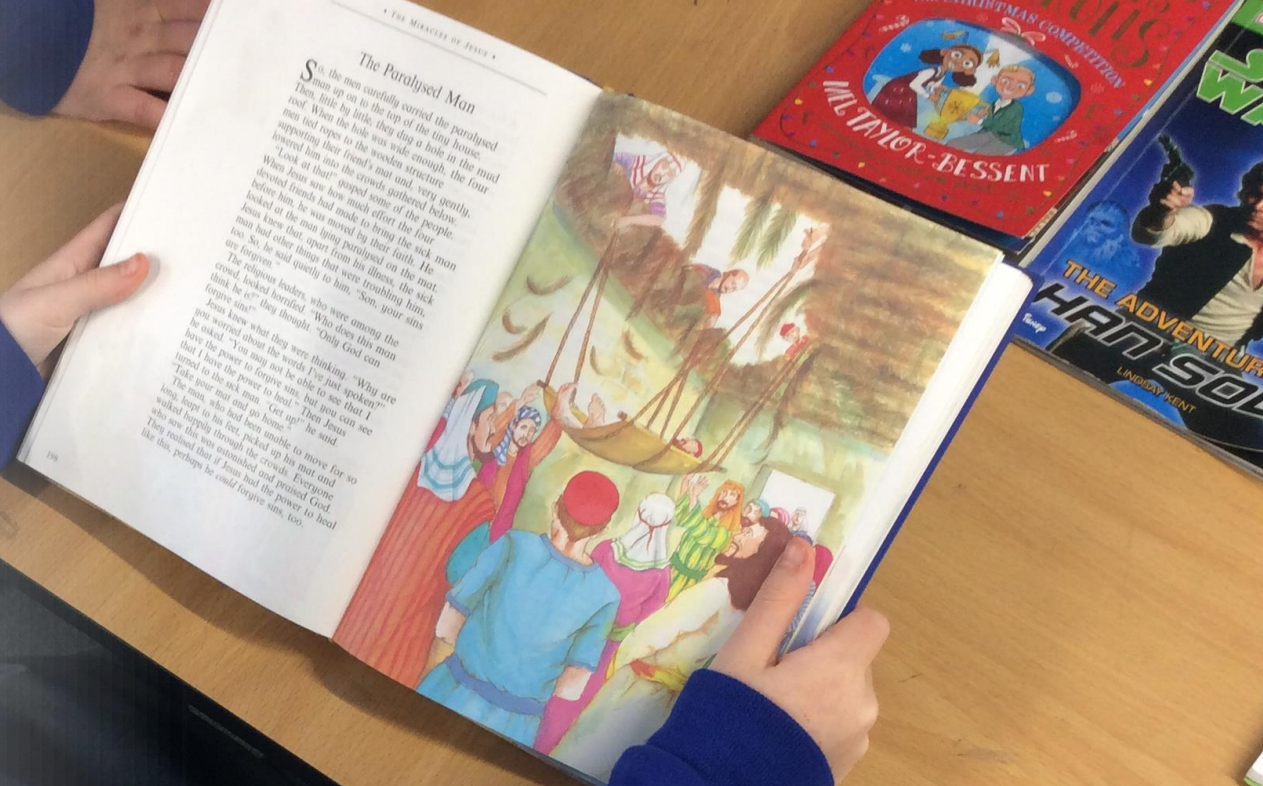


We celebrate

His 4 friends lowered him through the roof after cutting a hole in the roof.





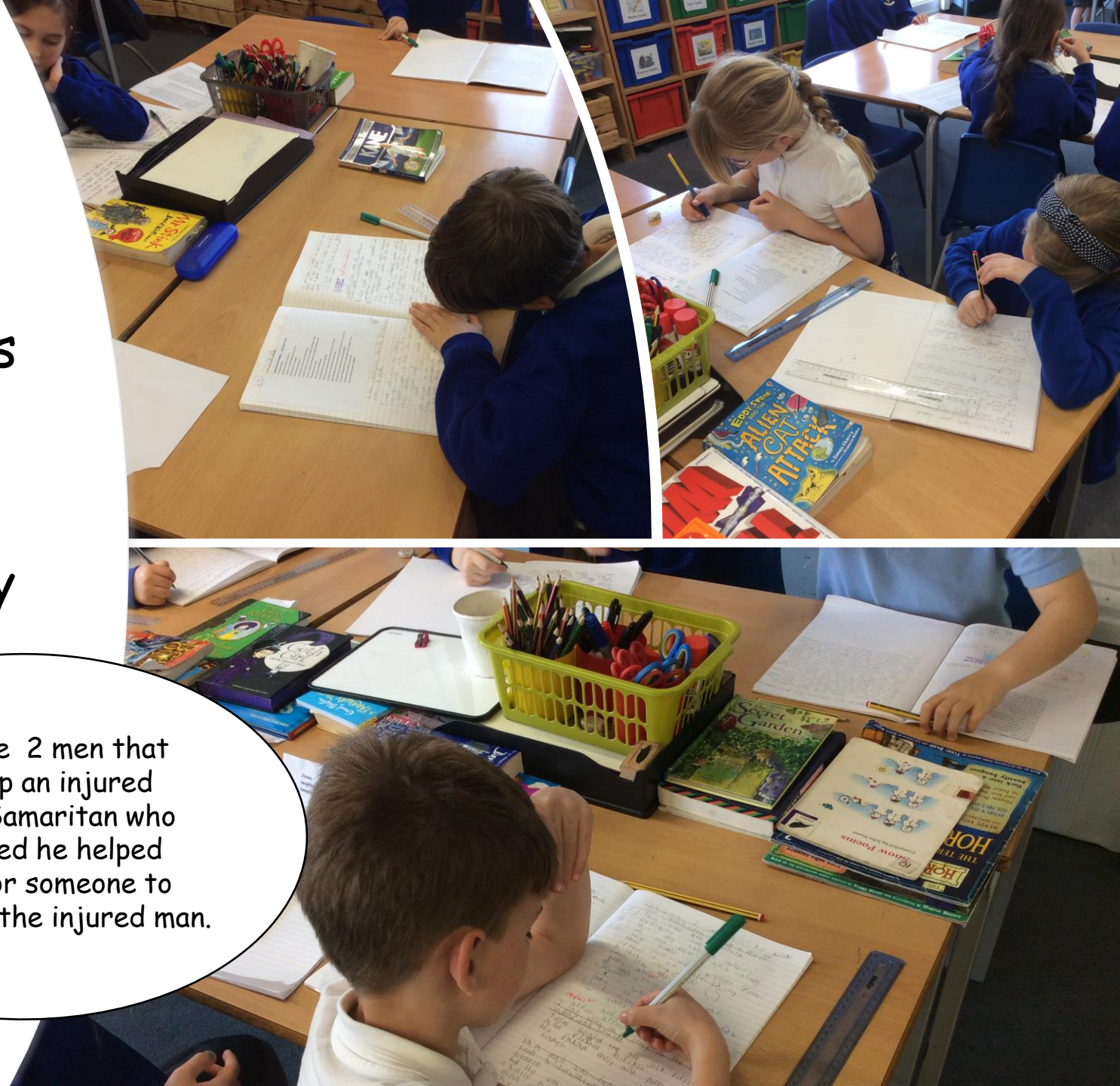

The Bible is the Christian Holy Book

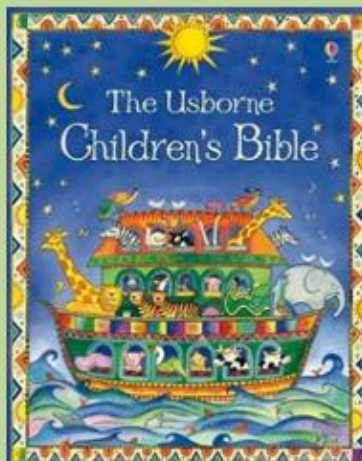
The Gospels are in the New Testament and they tell the story of Jesus.
