Different faiths and communities have different ways of welcoming a new baby, for example, a Christian baptism or a naming ceremony.

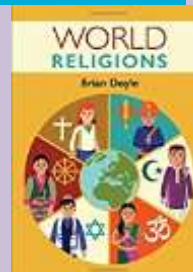
Different faiths and communities have different ways of making a promise to love and look after each other.
