



Some of the songs are very 'high' so difficult for us to hit some of the notes.




Some of the songs sounded sad and where harder to listen to.



Subject Specific Vocabulary

ABBA	a group made of 2 female and 2 male singers from Sweden who had hits in the 1970's and 1980's.

Tuned percussion instruments	are instruments that play a particular note or notes.
Untuned percussion instruments	are instruments that are not tuned to make a particular note.
Appraise	express an opinion with reasoning, I like... because.... I do not like.... Because...
Tempo	means the speed of the music
