





We recalled what we remembered about France and French.










We went around the class saying, "Bonjour" or "Hello" in different ways.



In pairs we asked, "What is your name" and then responded.




How are you?




We then learnt the different ways to say, "Goodbye" for different circumstances.

Un, deux, trois.....






Finally using our knowledge we asked our friends how old they are. They had to respond in French.
