season

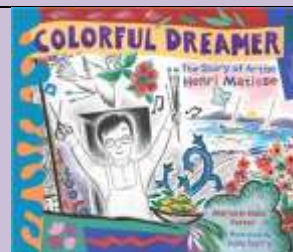
