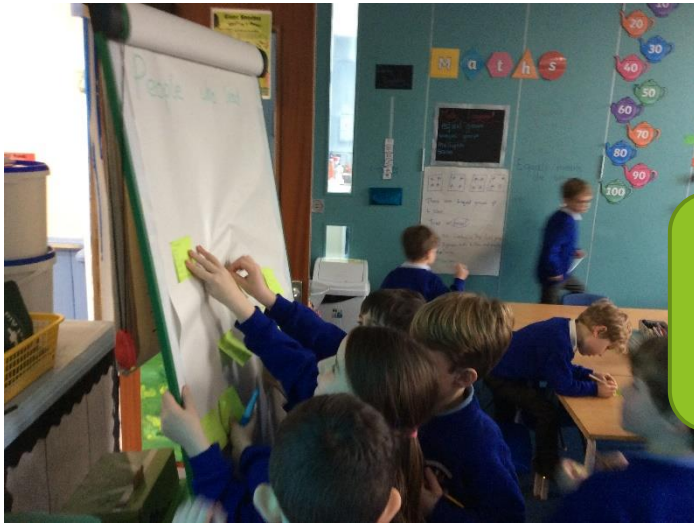

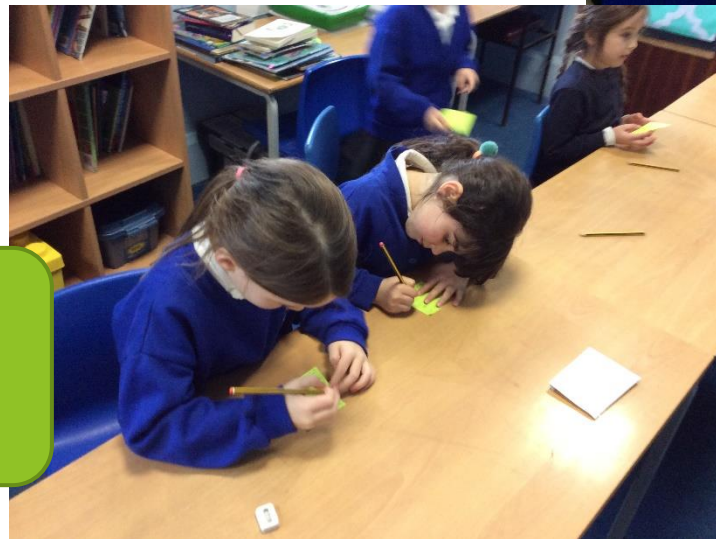
# People who lead

Muhammad (may peace be upon him).

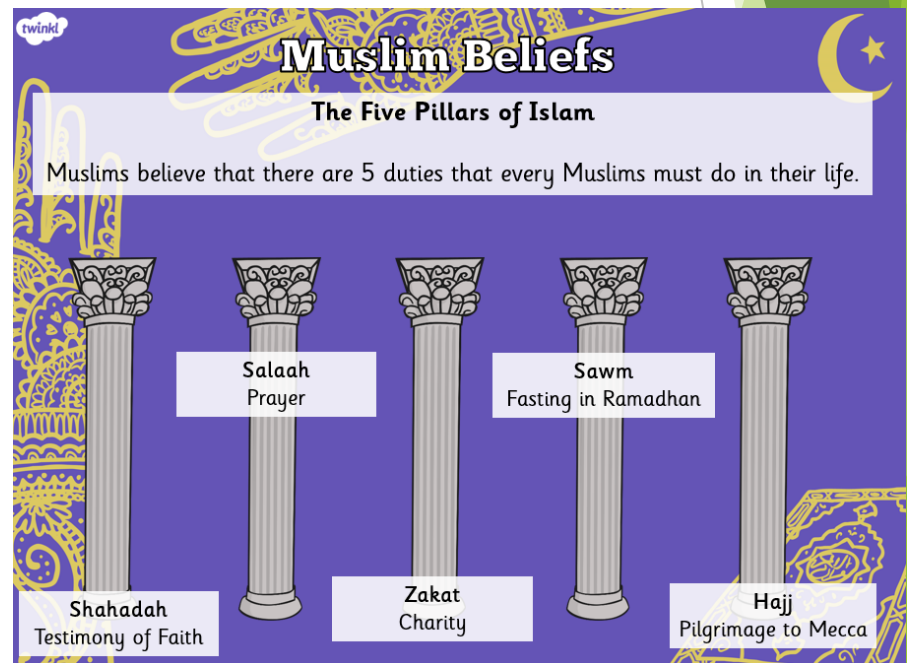
Muslims believe Muhammad is a prophet of Allah.

The 5 Pillars tell Muslims what to do.

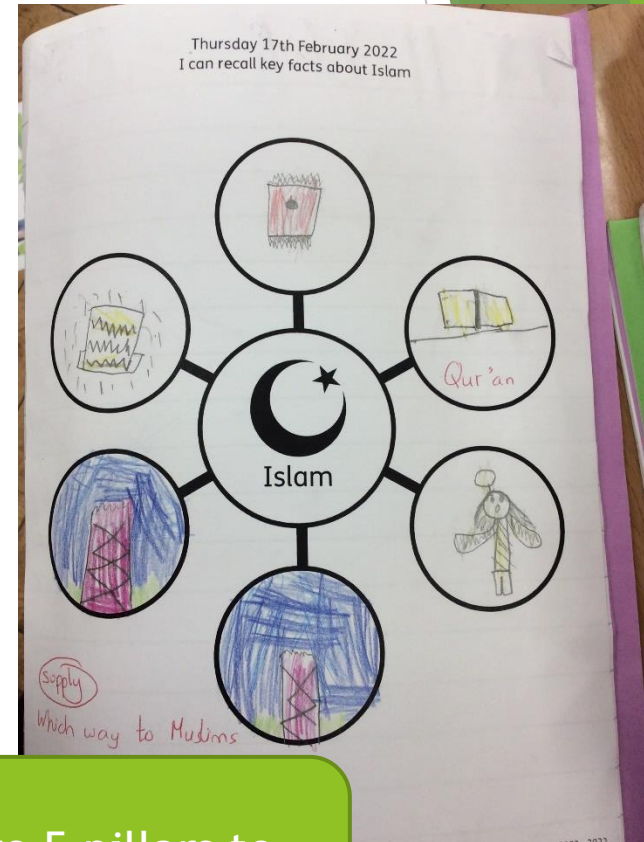
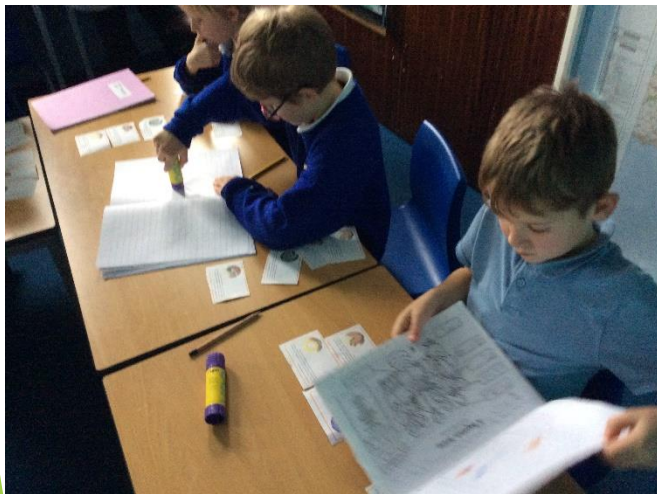
A pilgrimage is a journey Muslims take to Mecca to show their faith.

Salah	Muslim word for 'prayer'
Prophet Muhammad	The messenger of Allah and said to be the founder of Islam.
