It was interesting to see how all the parts needed each other because if one part is missing it probably wouldn't work.




Next we looked at what a search engine is, what they do and how you use them. We looked at how you need to be precise with what you are looking for or may end up with the wrong thing.



We learnt that if you are searching for a place you need to be specific and add more information to make sure for example you get rugby the place and not rugby the sport.





We learnt more about how search engines work and the role of web crawlers.

A web crawler goes to the different sites and creates an index of what they have.








We created our own paper-based websites to help us to understand how websites are ranked when you search.


